

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 140200

Quarter corner common to Sections 30 and 31, Township 39 South, Range 3 East, W.M. $V = 20^\circ$

Found, at the corner, a mound of stone, which I replaced with a 1 x 36-inch Galvanized iron pipe projecting 2½-inch diameter bronze disc marked:

JACKSON COUNTY
T39S R3E
30
¼S —
31
1980

From which I found the original bearing tree marked by E.T.T. Fisher in 1858:

- White Oak, 16-inch diameter with reverse scribe marks in opened upper face, bears Record: $N5^\circ E$, 33.00 feet to upper face.

I mark a new tree "CS" "BT":

- Easterly White Oak in a group of three, 16-inch diameter bears $N39^\circ W$, 186.72 feet to center of tree at lower blaze.
- I chiseled an "X" and place lead plug in center of a 4x2x2 ½ feet stone, located at base of original bearing tree. "X" bears $N18^\circ E$, 32.62 feet.
- I raised mound of stone around corner.

Corner lies about 200 feet South of ridge; course East-West.
