

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 200340

Quarter corner common to Sections 19 and 20, Township 39 South, Range 3 East, W.M. $V = 19^\circ$

From the following original evidence and at the location described below, I set a 1 x 36-inch Galvanized iron pipe 34 inches in the ground with a 2½-inch bronze disc marked:

T39S R3E
¼S
19 | 20
C.S.
1973

From which:

- An original BT., a Fir, now 35-inch diameter containing partial scribed "BT" bears N36°E, 188.5 feet (196.6 feet on slope). Record: N36°E, 193.38 feet.
- An original BT., a White Oak, now 5-inch diameter, containing partial scribed BT, bears Record: N72°W, 12.54 feet.

I mounded stones around corner and marked the following trees CS BT:

- A Douglas Fir, 13-inch diameter, bears N71°45'E, 25.25 feet to center of tree at lower blaze.
- A Douglas Fir, 26-inch diameter, bears South, 11.57 feet to center of tree at lower blaze.
