

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

Section corner common to Sections 17, 18, 19 and 20, Township 39 South, Range 3 East, W.M.

Found a stone marked:

In a mound of stone for corner.

Set a 1" x 36" galvanized iron pipe 6" in the ground and raised a mound of stone, said pipe has a 2½" bronze cap stamped:

From which:

- A 40" Pine plainly scribed bears S47°E, 47.5 feet to the face of the upper blaze.
- A 36" Pine plainly scribed bears S10°W, 136.0 feet to the face of the upper blaze.
- A 36" Pine plainly scribed bears N63¾°W, 220.1 feet to the face of the upper blaze.
- The center of the stump ring of a down and badly rotted Pine with a scribed pitch slab, bears N51°E, 23.0 feet.
- Scribed a 12" Fir CS-BT which bears N62½°E, 14.1 feet to the face of the lower blaze.
