

GCDB 240500

Perpetuation of the original evidence found at the corner common to Sections 8 and 17, Township 39 South, Range 3 East, W.M.

Found a mound of stone in a dry ravine for corner.

Set a 1" x 36" iron pipe, 13" in the ground to bedrock with brass cap stamped:

T39S R3E

¼S —
17
¼ Cor.
C.S. 1961

For corner in a mound of stone from which:

- The original witness tree (now a 43" Fir snag), plainly scribed "¼ S" bears S55°W, 161.0 feet.
- The original witness tree (now a 34" dead Fir with blazes healed bears N53°E, 83.8 feet.

I marked new trees as follows:

- A 12" White Fir, scribed CS-BT bears N2½°W, 101.5 feet.
- An 18" White Fir, scribed CS-BT bears N87½°E, 80.4 feet.
