

## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 300200

Section corner common to Sections 28, 29, 32 and 33, Township 39 South, Range 3 East, W.M.  
V = 19°

Found original NE BT, a Pine now 45-inch diameter containing scribe marks in opened face.

At record bearing and distance (N15°E, 71.94 feet from scribed face), I set a 1 x 36-inch Galvanized iron pipe 27 inches in the ground with a 2½-inch bronze disc marked:

T39S	R3E
S29	S28
S32	S33

A stump depression found at location of original SW BT. All other evidence presumed to have been destroyed by logging activity in immediate area.

I mounded stone around corner, marked the following trees CS BT and took measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- A White Fir, 10-inch diameter, bears N33½°E, 36.6 feet.
- A Pine, 12-inch diameter, bears S80½°E, 12.8 feet.
- A Douglas Fir, 20-inch diameter, bears S59°W, 9.7 feet.
- A Douglas Fir, 11-inch diameter, bears N66½°W, 64.1 feet.

Corner lies 9 feet South of E-W fence line.
