

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 340600

Quarter corner common to Sections 4 and 9, Township 39 South, Range 3 East, W.M. $V = 19\frac{3}{4}^\circ$

From original BT recorded by S. Truax in 1859 described below:

I set a 1 x 36-inch Galvanized iron pipe 30 inches in the ground with a 2½-inch bronze disc marked:

T39S R3E

Jackson County 1974

From which:

- The found BT., a White Fir, 30-inch diameter, containing partial scribed "B" and "T" in exposed lower face, bears Record: S31°E, 19.14 feet to scribed face.
- The remains of a rotted Fir stump, found at the location of the original NE BT.
- A Found Galvanized iron pipe, 1½-inch diameter, projecting 20 inches, bears S55°W, 3.95 feet.

I mounded stones around corner, marked the following trees CS BT and took measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- A White Fir, 8-inch diameter, bears N27½°E, 35.21 feet.
- A White Fir, 16-inch diameter, bears S86°W, 32.85 feet.
