

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 400600

Section corner common to Sections 3, 4, 9 and 10, Township 39 South, Range 3 East, W.M.

Found a $\frac{3}{4}$ " iron pin set for corner on Recorded Survey #3544.

Set a 1" x 36" galvanized iron pipe 32" in the ground, directly over said pin, with a 2½" bronze cap stamped:

From which:

- The original bearing tree, a 40" Yellow Pine bears N46°E, 122.1 feet to the face of the upper blaze.
- The stump of a 24" Fir bears S49¾°E, 126.7 feet to an old face.
- The stump of a 24" Fir plainly scribed bears approximately N25°W, 72 ± feet. This stump is now directly behind a 30" Fir tree.

Marked the following new trees:

- A 12" yellow Pine scribed CS-BT bears S1¼°E, 77.0 feet to the face of the upper blaze.
- A 16" Fir scribed CS-BT bears S87½°E, 99.8 feet to the face of the upper blaze.
- A 12" Fir scribed CS-BT bears N81°W, 10.6 feet to the face of the lower blaze.

Found at the corner, the 1-inch diameter galvanized iron pipe, projecting 4 inches, with 2½-inch diameter brass cap marked:

Set on First re-establishment, in 1967.

From which, original bearing trees marked in 1859 by S. Truax found:

- Yellow pine stump, 45-inch diameter, bears Record: N46°E, 122.1 feet to rotted face.
- Fir stump shell bears Record: N25°W, 71.28 feet to estimated face.

Bearing trees marked in 1967 found:

- Yellow Pine, 21-inch diameter, bears S1¼°E, 77.4 feet to center of tree at lower healed blaze. Record: 77.0 feet to face.
- White Fir, 18-inch diameter, bears, N80½°W, 11.1 feet to center of tree at lower healed blaze. Record: N81°W, 10.6 feet to face.
- White Fir, 21-inch diameter, bears S88°E, 100.4 feet to center of tree at lower healed blaze. Record: S87½°E, 99.8 feet to face.

Mark a new tree "CS" "BT":

- White Fir, 18-inch diameter, bears N24°E, 84.45 feet to center at lower blaze.

Corner lies about 35 feet South of Middle Table Mountain Road, three tenths of a mile West of intersection of Table Mt. Road and Hyatt-Howard Road.

Hung K-tag along Hyatt-Howard Rd 1000± feet East of section corner.
