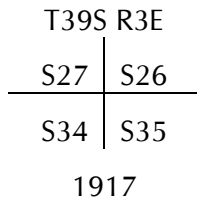


**FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT**

**GCDB 500200**

Section corner common to Sections 26, 27, 34 and 35, Township 39 South, Range 3 East, W.M.

Found projecting 9 inches from a small mound of stones, the 1½-inch diameter iron pipe with standard GLO brass cap marked:



No original bearing trees found

Scribed new trees "CS" "BT" and took measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- Douglas Fir, 15-inch diameter, bears N70¾°E, 17.4 feet.
- Douglas Fir, 21-inch diameter, bears S46½°E, 5.15 feet.
- Douglas Fir, 18-inch diameter, bears S29¼°W, 26.7 feet.
- White Fir, 8-inch diameter, bears N56¾°W, 4.0 feet.

Corner lies in timber, on 25% northwesterly slope, an estimated 230 feet East of a location poster placed on a 12-inch diameter fir on the easterly side of a gravel road, course S40°W and N50°W.
