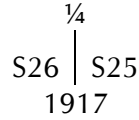


**FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT**

**GCDB 600240**

Quarter corner common to Sections 25 and 26, Township 39 South, Range 3 East, W.M.

Found projecting 14 inches, the 3/4-inch diameter iron pipe with standard General Land Office brass cap marked:



Set by Fred W. Rodolf on 1917 retracement survey.

Original bearing tree marked by Sewell Truax in 1859 found:

- Pine, now 23-inch diameter with single healed blaze, (apparently re-scribed by Rodolf), bears Record: N59°E, 36.96 feet to estimated face. Re-measured 37.5 feet to center of tree near base.

Bearing tree marked in 1917 found:

- Cedar, now 23-inch diameter with scribed "S" visible in partially healed single blaze, bears S53¼°W, 47.5 feet to face, 49.15 feet to center of tree near base. Record: S52°W.

Corner lies in a small opening, on a 10% southerly slope, an estimated 600 feet north of a location poster nailed to a 36-inch diameter cedar on the north side of a road.
