

## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 600440

Quarter corner common to Sections 13 and 14, Township 39 South, Range 3 East, W.M.

Set a 1" x 36" galvanized iron pipe 28" in the ground in a mound of stone with 2½" bronze cap stamped:

T39S R3E  
¼ 14 | 13 Cor.  
C.S.  
1971

For corner.

From which:

- The original bearing tree, (now a 42" White Fir with scribe "¼S" visible) bears S81°E, 45.6 feet to face of the upper blaze.
- The original bearing tree, (now a 36" White Fir stump) bears N54¼°W, 49.8 feet to center of the stump.

Marked the following new trees:

- A 22" White Fir scribed "CS-BT", bears N67°W, 18.5 feet to face of the lower blaze.
- An 18" White Fir, scribed "CS-BT", bears N8¾°E, 13.5 feet to face of the lower blaze.
