Quarter corner common to Sections 1 and 2, Township 39 South, Range 3 East, W.M.

Found at the corner position, exposed 2 inches and in a ring of stones, the 1-inch diameter galvanized iron pipe with a 2½-inch diameter brass cap set on First Re-establishment in 1962, marked:

Bearing trees recorded on said First Re-establishment, found with healed double blazes and measured to center of trees at lower blaze:

- White Fir, now 18-inch diameter bears N8°W, 19.2 feet. Record: N10°W.
- White Fir, now 12-inch diameter bears Record: \$70½°W, 14.4 feet.

Marked new bearing trees "CS" "BT" and took measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- White Fir 9-inch diameter bears N48°E, 29.0 feet.
- White Fir 6-inch diameter bears N54°W, 49.2 feet.
