

## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 640200

Quarter corner common to Sections 25 and 36, Township 39 South, Range 3 East, W.M. V =  $19\frac{1}{4}^\circ$

From the following evidence and at a location as noted below:

- I set a 1 x 36-inch Galvanized iron pipe 30 inches in the ground with a 2½-inch bronze disc marked:

From which:

- An original BT., now a Pine snag, approximately 6 feet high containing scribed "BT" bears Record:  $S36^\circ W$ , 47.52 feet.
- An original BT., a Pine now 33-inch diameter, with lower section partially burned out, containing scribed "BT", bears  $N40^\circ W$ , 47.52 feet. Record:  $N48^\circ W$ , 47.52 feet.

I mounded stones around corner, marked the following trees CS BT and took measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- A Juniper, 10-inch diameter, bears  $S27^\circ W$ , 45.8 feet.
- A Juniper, 6-inch diameter, bears  $N59^\circ W$ , 42.0 feet.
