

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 640500

Quarter corner common to Sections 12 and 13, Township 39 South, Range 3 East, W.M. $V = 21\frac{1}{4}^\circ$

Found original SE BT, a White Fir, now 19-inch diameter, containing scribed "¼S" in partially healed blaze. At record bearing and distance, S55°E, 9.9 feet (to scribed face).

I set a 1 x 36-inch Galvanized iron pipe 24 inches in the ground with a 2½-inch bronze disc marked:

I mounded stones around corner.

Marked the following trees CS BT and took measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- A White Fir, 11-inch diameter, bears N74°E, 34.1 feet.
- A White Fir, 18-inch diameter, bears S15°E, 36.1 feet.

Corner lies approximately 175 feet South of location marker alongside Road
