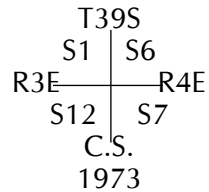


## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

### GCDB 100600

Section corner common to Sections 1 and 12, Township 39 South, Range 3 East, and Sections 6 and 7, Township 39 South, Range 4 East, W.M.  $V=21^\circ$

From the following evidence and at a location as noted below, I set a 1 x 36-inch Galvanized iron pipe set 26 inches in the ground with a 2½-inch bronze disc marked:



From which:

Original BTs found as follows:

- A White Fir, 13-inch diameter, containing scribed "S6" in partially open face bears  $N74\frac{1}{2}^\circ E$ , 11.88 feet to scribed face. Record:  $N71^\circ E$ , 11.88 feet.
- A White Fir, 23-inch diameter, containing scribed "T39" and "SR" in partially open face bears  $S19\frac{1}{2}^\circ E$ , 15.84 feet to scribed face. Record:  $S22^\circ E$ , 15.84 feet.
- A White Fir, 17-inch diameter, with healed blazes bears  $S67^\circ W$ , 9.8 feet to center of tree. Record:  $S67^\circ W$ , 9.24 feet.
- A White Fir snag, 19-inch diameter, approximately 13 feet high, with healed blaze bears  $N75^\circ W$ , 13.9 feet to center of tree. Record:  $N78^\circ W$ , 13.86 feet.
- Square head nails marked with "W" were found at the base of each of the above trees.

I mounded stones around corner, marked the following trees CS BT and took measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- A White Fir, 14-inch diameter bears  $N28^\circ E$ , 23.95 feet.
- A White Fir, 12-inch diameter bears  $S3\frac{1}{2}^\circ E$ , 58.0 feet.
- A White Fir, 12-inch diameter bears  $S42^\circ W$ , 33.6 feet.
- A Cedar, 15-inch diameter bears  $N49^\circ W$ , 12.75 feet.
