

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 140600

Quarter corner common to Sections 6 and 7, Township 39 South, Range 4 East, W.M. $V = 19^\circ$

In a found mound of stones, I set a 1 x 36-inch Galvanized iron pipe 12 inches in the ground, with a 2½-inch bronze disc marked:

Original BTs recorded by S. Truax in 1859, found as follows:

- Cedar, 31-inch diameter, containing scribed "4" and "S" in burned face bears record, $S38^\circ W$, 107.58 feet to scribed face.
- Ponderosa Pine, 25-inch diameter, scribed "BT" bears record, $N1^\circ W$, 75.90 feet to scribed face.

I marked a new tree CS BT:

- Ponderosa Pine, 12-inch diameter bears $N76^\circ W$, 25.30 feet to center of tree at lower blaze.

Corner lies near North edge of rocky meadow.
