

## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 240500

Quarter corner common to Sections 8 and 17, Township 39 South, Range 4 East, W.M.

Found, the original corner monument recorded by P. Applegate in 1893, a Fir tree, now down and decayed, of indeterminate diameter, a section of which contains scribe marks including "S".

In the stump remains and root hole of the above, set a 1 x 36-inch Galvanized iron pipe 30 inches in the ground, with a 2½-inch diameter brass cap marked:

For the corner, from which the stump hole containing fir remains and roots of an original bearing tree bears Record: N85°E, 6.60 feet.

Marked new trees "CS" "BT" and took measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- White Fir, 10-inch diameter bears S9°E, 3.60 feet.
- Douglas Fir, 11-inch diameter bears N30½°W, 33.80 feet.

Corner lies at North end of small bench at top of (40%) North slope, an estimated 1350 feet East of location marker on 15-inch diameter Fir stump, alongside road.
