

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 600440

Quarter corner common to Sections 13 and 14, Township 39 South, Range 4 East, W.M. $V = 20^\circ$

From the following evidence at the location described below, I set a 1 x 36-inch Galvanized iron pipe 24 inches in the ground with a 2½-inch bronze disc marked:

Original BTs recorded by S. Truax in 1859, found as follows:

- Sawed Fir stump, 27-inch diameter, containing reverse impression of axed chain notch bears record N69°E, 23.76 feet to said chain notch.
- Sawed Pine stump, 30-inch diameter, scribed "BT" bears N38°W, 12.54 feet to scribed face. Record, N44°W, 12.54 feet.

I mounded stones around corner, marked new trees CS BT and took measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- White Fir, 14-inch diameter bears S75¾°E, 32.56 feet.
- White Fir, 10-inch diameter bears S31°W, 11.80 feet.

Corner lies on blazed North-South line about 1,100 feet West of road.
