

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 700240

Quarter corner common to Sections 25 and 30, Township 39 South, Ranges 4 and 5 East, W.M.
 $V = 17^\circ$

From the following evidence at the location described below, I set a 1 x 36-inch Galvanized iron pipe 24 inches in the ground with a 2½-inch bronze disc marked:

Jackson County 1975
T39S
¼S
25 | 30
R4E R5E

Original BTs marked by S. Truax in 1859, found as follows:

- The sawed stump, 26-inch diameter, (containing scribed "T" in burned face) of a down Cedar, partial scribed "¼S" bears Record: N43°E, 31.68 feet to burned face.
- A Sugar Pine stump, 33-inch diameter, scribed "BT" in exposed lower face bears Record: S71°W, 42.24 feet to scribed face.

I marked new trees CS BT and took measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- Douglas Fir, 18-inch diameter bears S62°E, 22.25 feet.
- Cedar, 17-inch diameter bears S36°W, 26.90 feet.
