

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 100100

Corner to Township 40 and 41 South, Range 3 and 4 West, W.M.

Found no evidence of the original corner stone.

At the corner point, set a 2" x 36" iron pipe 22" in the ground, from which:

- The original witness tree (now a 12" Yellow Pine snag) plainly scribed T40SR3W S31-BT bears N66½°E, 27.1 feet.
- The original witness tree (now a 20" Yellow Pine) plainly scribed "S1" which bears S24½°W, 22.4 feet.
- A 26" Fir stump with old axe face and partially healed blaze which bears N5½°W, 14.5 feet.

I took new trees as follows:

- A 6" Fir, scribed CS-BT bears N38½°E, 42.2 feet.
- A 6" live oak scribed CS-BT bears S80½°E, 10.9 feet.
- An 8" Fir, scribed CS-BT bears S17°W, 13.6 feet.
- A 3" White Oak, scribed CS-BT bears N64°W, 12.6 feet.
