

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 100240

Quarter corner common to Section 25, Township 40 South, Range 4 West, and Section 30, Township 40 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

Found a 2 x 7 x 13-inch wash boulder with $\frac{1}{4}$ scribed on face, also a 4" x 5" wood post, the recognized corner, together with a pine stump which agrees with the record bearing tree, also a Black Oak with old axe marks which agrees with the record bearing tree.

Set a 1" x 36" galvanized iron pipe 34" in the ground for corner with the said stone alongside.

From which:

- An 8" Black Oak scribed "CS-BT" bears $S78^{\circ}E$, 11.8 feet.
- Scribe a 10" Black Oak "CS-BT", which bears $N14\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$, 59.6 feet.
