

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 140200

Quarter corner common to Sections 30 and 31, Township 40 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

At the corner, found the original 15 x 12 x 8-inch stone, firmly set and marked "¼" on North side as recorded by S. Lackland in 1882.

Replaced said stone with and deposited it alongside a 1 x 36-inch Galvanized iron pipe, set 26 inches in the ground with a 2½-inch diameter bronze cap marked:

The single remaining original bearing tree,

- A White Oak, now 6-inch diameter, containing reverse impression of (partial) scribed "BT" bears Record: N71°E, 20.46 feet to said (reverse) face.

Marked new trees "CS" "BT" and took measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- White Oak, 5-inch diameter bears N49°E, 30.65 feet.
- Yellow Pine, 14-inch diameter bears S19°E, 39.39 feet.

Corner lies on South (50%) slope.
