

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 140400

Quarter Section corner common to Sections 18 and 19, Township 40 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

Found a 17 x 12 x 8-inch wash boulder with $\frac{1}{4}$ scribed on the North face,

Also the stump of Pine to Southeast which agrees with the Southeast bearing tree, a stump hole of a Pine agrees with the Northwest bearing tree:

From which evidence:

- Set a 1" x 36" galvanized iron pipe 32" in the ground for corner with the said stone set alongside of the pipe

From which:

- A 10" Black Oak scribed CS-BT bears N49°E, 49.2 feet.
- Scribe a 24" Black Oak CS-BT which bears S41½°W, 86.4 feet.
- Found old blaze to the North.
