

## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

### GCDB 200600

Re-establishment of Section Corner common to Sections 5, 6, 7 and 8, Township 40 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

Found a 3 x 8 x 18-inch stone with five grooves on two sides, also stump of 16" Black Oak scribed "T40S R3W - BT" to Northwest, also remains of pine roots to Southwest and old mining ditch to West,:

From which evidence:

- Set a 2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe 33" in the ground for corner.

From which:

- A 16" Black Oak scribed CS-BT bears N13½°E, 43.2 feet.
- A 10" Fir scribed CS-BT bears N64½°W, 26.7 feet (on upper bank of mining ditch)
- An 8" forked Black Oak scribed CS-BT bears S38°E, 48.0 feet.
- A 4" White Oak scribed CS-BT bears S51½°W, 48.6 feet.
