

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 240600

Quarter corner common to Sections 5 and 8, Township 40 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

- Found the stump of the original Yellow Pine bearing tree with down log plainly scribed.
- Also the original Oak bearing tree with old blazes, but no scribe visible.

For corner, set a 1" x 36" galvanized iron pipe, 31" in the ground, from which:

- The original Oak bearing tree bears S60°W, 15.9 feet.
- The original Pine bearing tree (now a stump) bears N45°E, 26.6 feet.

From said pipe corner, I establish the following new witness trees:

- A 5" Fir, scribed CS-BT bears N3¾°E, 14.1 feet.
- A 10" Fir, scribed CS-BT bears S33°E, 23.8 feet.
