

## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 300600

Section corner common to Sections 4, 5, 8 and 9, Township 40 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

Found a slate stone on top of the ground, marked as reported in the official records. Also all original bearing trees plainly scribed.

Set a 1" x 36" galvanized iron pipe for corner referenced with the following trees:

- Original White Oak (now 11") bears N15°E, 20.9 feet.
- Original White Oak (now 17") bears N25°W, 23.4 feet.
- Original White Oak (now 11") snag bears S41°W, 22.2 feet.

From said pipe corner, I establish new witness trees as follows:

- A 10" Fir scribed CS-BT bears N32°W, 4.4 feet.
- A 9" Fir scribed CS-BT bears S41°E, 1.6 feet.
- A 12" Fir scribed CS-BT bears N76½°E, 8.1 feet.
- A 9" Fir scribed CS-BT bears S8½°W, 24.0 feet.
