

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 700500

Section corner on Range Line common to Sections 7 and 18, Township 40 South, Range 2 West and Sections 12 and 13, Township 40 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

Found stone corner lying on top of ground near corner.

Also found

- Stump of original BT to Northwest with scribe legible.
- Stump of BT to Southwest with old blaze, no scribe visible.
- Also remains of BTs to Northeast and Southeast,

From which evidence:

- Set a 2" x 26" galvanized iron pipe 20" in the ground for corner.

From which:

- A 14" Douglas Fir, scribed CS-BT bears N37½°E, 25.8 feet.
- Scribe an 8" Douglas Fir CS-BT, which bears S25°E, 3.4 feet.
- Scribe a 4" live Oak CS-BT which bears S51°W, 15.9 feet.
- Scribe a 12" Douglas Fir CS-BT which bears N84°W, 31.4 feet.
