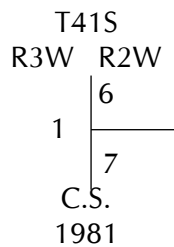


**FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT
CORNER COMMON TO SECTIONS 6 AND 7 ONLY
GCDB 100600**

Section corner common to Sections 6 and 7 ONLY, Township 41 South, Range 2 West, on the West line of said township and range.

At the corner, found firmly set, the original 24x21x6-inch slate stone marked: "CC" on the East face and 1 groove on the North, set by E. Henry in 1908.

Replaced said stone with and deposited it alongside a 2x32-inch Galvanized iron pipe set 25 inches in the ground with a 2½-inch diameter brass cap marked:



Original bearing trees found:

- Douglas Fir, 17-inch diameter, containing scribe marks in partially exposed single face bears Record: N47°E, 23.10 feet to center of tree.
- The base of a tipped over Sugar Pine, 65-inch diameter, containing scribe marks including "41WS" in partially opened face bears Record: S17°E, 42.90 feet on slope.

Mounded stones around corner and marked a new tree "CS" "BT":

- Douglas Fir, 5-inch diameter bears S59°E, 31.78 feet.

Corner lies 20 feet West of top of small ridge c. N20°W.
