

**FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT**

**GCDB 140600**

Quarter corner common to Sections 6 and 7, Township 41 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

At the corner, found firmly set, the original 14x13x3-inch stone (no discernible marks) set by E. Henry in 1908.

Replaced said stone with a 2x32-inch Galvanized iron pipe, set 24 inches in the ground, with a 2½-inch diameter brass cap marked:

Original bearing trees found:

- Pine stump shell, 24-inch diameter, containing fragments with scribe marks, including "BT" bears Record: N42°E, 24.42 feet to center.
- Douglas Fir, 38-inch diameter, with healed single blaze bears Record: S58°E, 34.32 feet to center.

Mounded stones around corner, deposited original stone alongside and marked a new tree "CS" "BT":

- Douglas Fir, 8-inch diameter bears N31°E, 26.45 feet to center of tree at lower blaze.

Corner lies on Northerly (25%) slope and on east-west blazed line.
