

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 400640

Quarter corner common to Sections 3 and 4, Township 41 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

Found at the corner position, exposed 12 inches in a mound of stones, the 1-inch diameter galvanized iron pipe with a 2½-inch diameter brass cap set by the GLO in 1916, marked:

Bearing trees recorded by Marshal Wright of the GLO in 1916, found with healed blazes and measured to center of trees at base:

- Fir, now 51-inch diameter bears N66°E, 51.1 feet. Record: N68°E, 50.2 feet to face.
- Fir, now 35-inch diameter bears N39°W, 44.0 feet (slope). Record: 43.6 feet (slope) to face.

Marked new bearing trees "CS" "BT" and took measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- Shasta fir 10-inch diameter bears S74¾°E, 13.3 feet.
- White Fir 13-inch diameter bears S85½°W, 8.0 feet.

Corner lies approximately 350 feet north of top of ridge and spur road on 45% slope.
