

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 500400

Closing corner common to Sections 14 and 15, Township 41 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

Found at the corner position, exposed 12 ins. in a mound of stones, the 2 ins. diam. galv. iron pipe with a 2½ ins. diam. brass cap set by the GLO in 1916, marked:

T41S R2W
CC
S15 | S14
CALIFORNIA
1916

Original bearing trees recorded by M. S. Wright of the GLO in 1916, found and measured to center at base:

- Fir, dead down and rotted brs. record; N 41½° E, 23.8 ft.
- Shasta Fir, now 30 ins. diam. with a healed single blaze, brs. record; N 67° W, 39.6 ft.

Mark new bearing tree "CS" "BT" and take measurement to center of tree at lower blaze:

- Shasta Fir 11 ins. diam. brs. N 72¼° E, 32.9 ft.

Corner lies approx. 800 ft. south of the ¼ corner common to Sections 14 and 15, and approx. 300 ft. west of the Pacific Crest Trail.
