

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 500540

Quarter corner common to Sections 10 and 11, Township 41 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

Found at the corner position, exposed 12 ins. in a mound of stones, the 1 in. diam. galv. iron pipe with a 2½ ins. diam. brass cap set by the GLO in 1916, marked:

Single remaining original bearing tree recorded by Fred Rodolf of the GLO in 1916,

- A W. Fir, now 23 ins. diam. with healed blazes brs. S25°W, 4.0 ft. record; S32°W.

Mark new bearing trees "CS" "BT" and take measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- West fork of a double W. Fir 10 ins. diam. brs. S75½°E, 5.8 ft.
- Shasta Fir 8 ins. diam. brs. N14°E, 28.9 ft.
- W. Fir 22 ins. diam. brs. N17¾°W, 11.7 ft.

Corner lies approx. 200 ft. west of spur road on a 65% slope.
