

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 600540

Quarter corner common to Sections 11 and 12, Township 41 South Range 2 West, W. M.

Found the 1 in. galvanized iron pipe with 2½ ins. diam. brass capped General Land Office monument marked;

S11 | S12
1916

Exposed 12 ins. and leaning westerly.

Straighten pipe and build small mound of stone around it, cap is rotated slightly northwest.

From which the single remaining bearing marked in 1916 found;

Red Fir snag 42 ins. diam., with scribe marks visible on opened burned face, brs. record S63°E, 14.56 ft. to center of tree at base.

Mark new trees 'CS BT' and measure to center of tree at base;

White Fir 13 ins. diam. brs. S01°E, 48.35 ft.

White Fir 19 ins. diam. brs. N05°W, 51.25 ft.

White Fir 6 ins. diam. marked 'X' 'BT', brs. N84°W, 21.90 ft.

Corner is located alongside old trail on southwest slope and northeast of Kettle Lake.
