

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 600640

Quarter corner common to Sections 1 and 2, Township 41 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

Found at the corner position, exposed 6 ins., the 1 in. diam. galv. iron pipe with a 2½ ins. diam. brass cap set by the GLO in 1916, marked:

Single remaining original bearing tree recorded by Fred Rodolf of the GLO in 1916,

- A Fir snag approx. 50 ins. diam. with healed blazes brs. N33°E, 46.9 ft. Record; N27°E.

Mark new bearing trees "CS" "BT" and take measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- Shasta Fir 24 ins. diam. brs. N37¾°E, 42.5 ft.
- White Fir 7 ins. diam. brs. S36¼°E, 35.9 ft.
- A chiseled "X" on the south face of a rock outcrop 1 ft. x 2 ft. x 1 ft. high brs. N25°W, 3.7 ft.

Corner lies approx. 500 ft. east from bend on gravel road and approx. 400 ft. north of creek.
